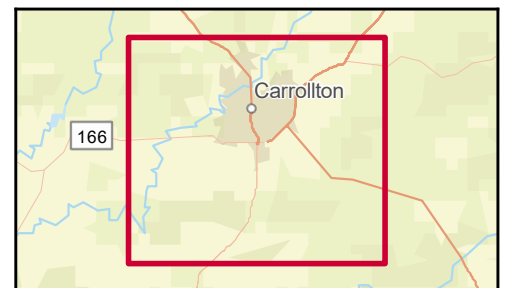
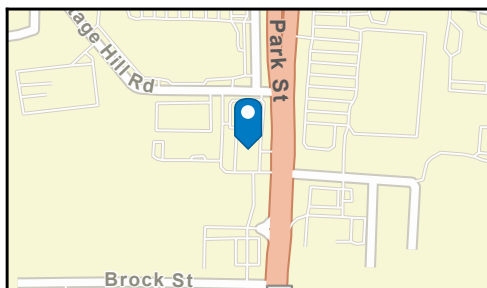
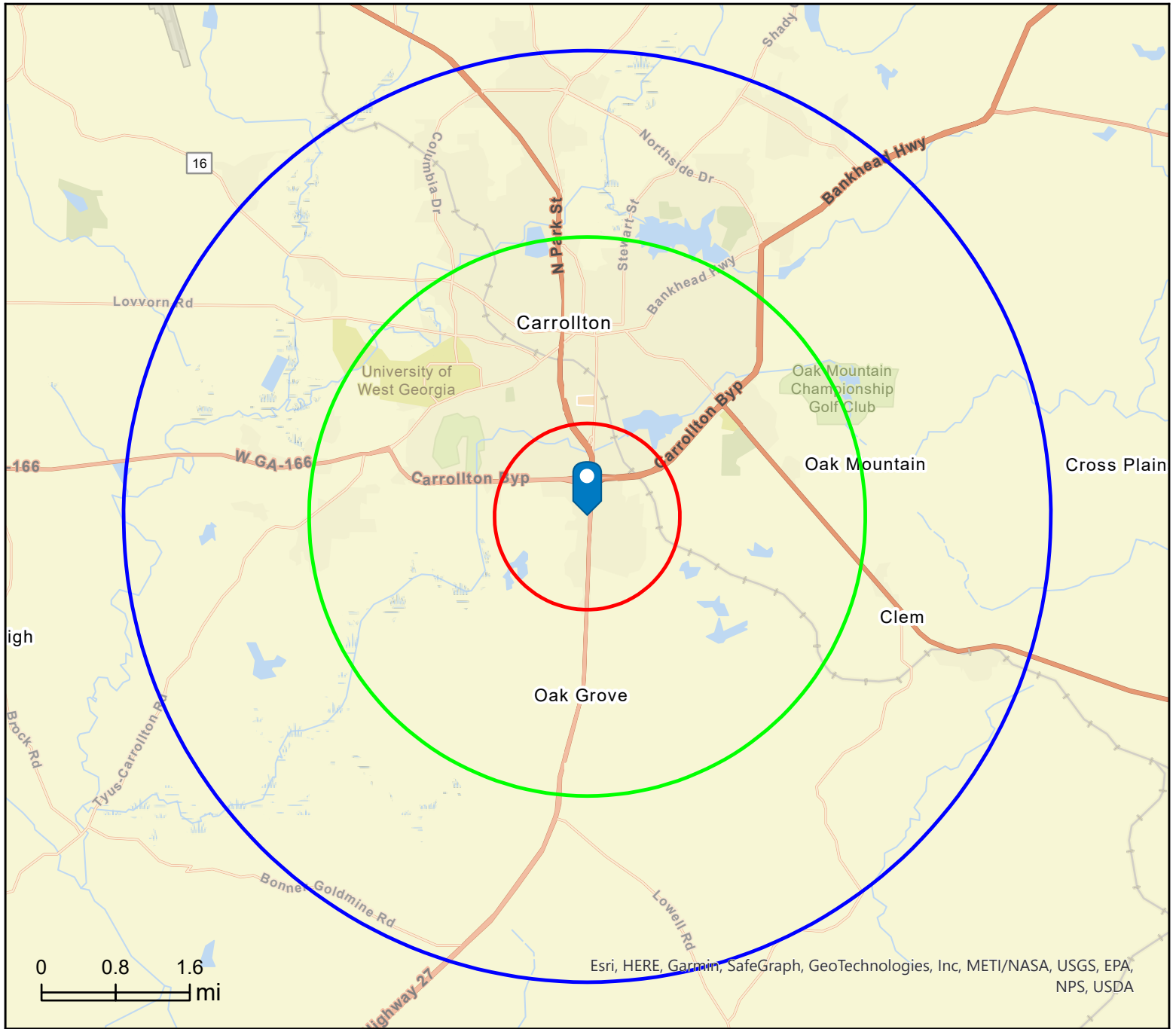

In the identified area, the current year population is 42,163. In 2020, the Census count in the area was 41,857. The rate of change since 2020 was 0.32% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 42,993 representing a change of 0.39% annually from 2022 to 2027. Currently, the population is 48.8% male and 51.2% female.

Currently, 48.5% of the 16,546 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 43.3%, renter occupied; and 8.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.2% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.8% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 16,383 housing units in the area and 8.1% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.44%. Median home value in the area is \$210,129, compared to a median home value of \$283,272 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 5.06% annually to \$268,991.
